My apologies for an incorrect statement about all day car parking in the News Flash issued earlier this week. Thanks to those who got in touch to point out the mistake.

Addingham

All day parking is **NOT** free. The Memorial Hall facility is for those attending events, the health centre, pharmacy, and for those using the playground and sports facilities. The two public car parks are small, heavily used with a 4 hour maximum wait. Very limited street parking so Addingham is not a good option unless you can get a lift, bus or walk.

Burley

There is a designated public car park at the Queen's Hall, which is now a bit smaller due to a recent extension to the building. There is limited street parking but be aware of the yellow lines etc.
